Background Information

LAVC population

- 16,591
- As of 2005-06 Overall Campus Gender
 - 60% female and 40% male

African-Descended population

- 1,031-53% female and 47% male
- 6.2% of total LAVC population

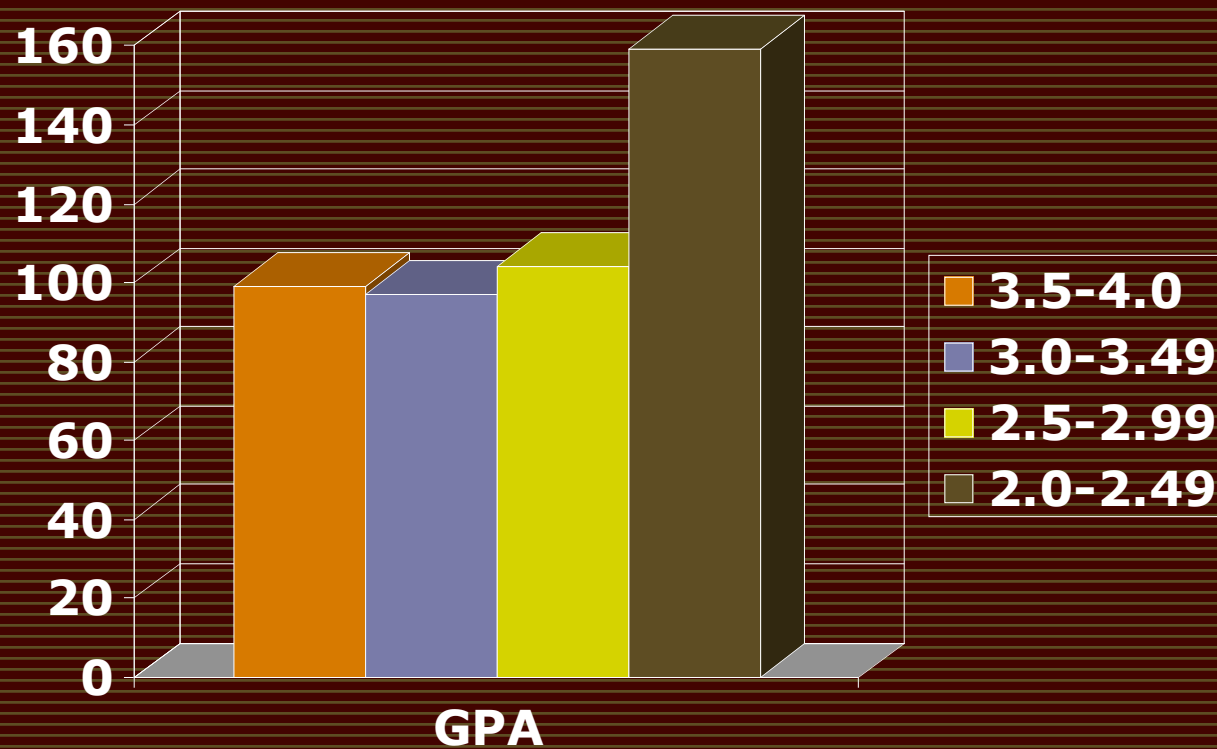
African-Descended Athletes

- 16 females and 67 males = 83
- 8% of African-Descended students are athletes

Grade Point Average

- ❑ African-Descended students who attempted at least 9 units
- ❑ Overall average-2.39
- ❑ Males-2.34
- ❑ Females-2.45
- ❑ Athletes-2.39

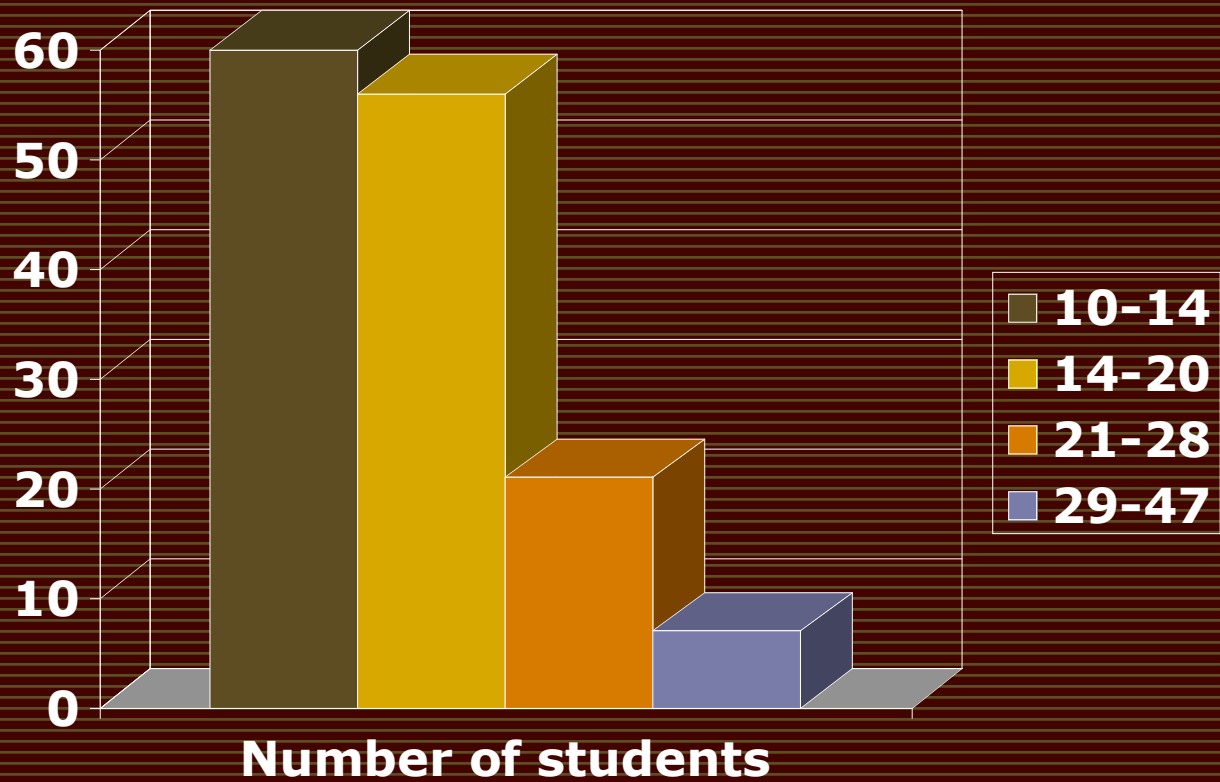
Grade Point Average-Range



African-Descended Students w/GPAs of 3.0 or Higher

- 3.0-3.5 GPA: 52
 - 35 Female; 17 Male
- Above 3.5 GPA: 95
 - 59 Female; 36 Male

Semesters at Valley



Retention & Success

- ❑ Student completes course
- ❑ African Descended-83%
 - 85% overall
- ❑ Student earns A, B, C or CR
- ❑ African Descended-53%
 - 65% overall

Probation

- ❑ 110 African Descended students
 - 11% of African Descended population
 - 56 males and 54 females
 - 11 athletes (out of 83)
 - 8 DSPS students (out of 65)

African-Descended Students with Transferable English & Math Completion

- ❑ Transferable English: 277
- ❑ Transferable Math: 51
- ❑ Both Transferable Math & English: 36

Transfer to UC/CSU 2005-2006

- ❑ African American-6/40
- ❑ Latino-27/217
- ❑ Asian American-29/42
- ❑ White-98/189

Support/Success Service Use Among African-Descended Students

- Trio (8)
 - Males – 5
 - Females – 3

- DSPPS (65)
 - Males – 29
 - Females – 36

- EOPS (77)
 - Males - 46
 - Females - 31

T.A.P./Honors Program

- ❑ African American students enrolled
 - 3 (all women)
- ❑ African American students eligible (3.25 G.P.A and 20 Units or More)
